**RULES FOR JUDGING CLUB WINNERS**  
**(The same rules apply for judging the District winner)**

1-10	Quality of Community Service Performed Please judge the overall quality of the community service performed by the candidate, not the total number of hours of service performed.	10 – Highest
1- 20	Non-required School and Community service More weight should be given to the initiative shown by the student and to community service that the student is not required to perform.	20 – Highest
1-5	What is Community Service?	5 – Highest
1-10	Why is Community Service Important to You?	10 – Highest
1-5	Principal or Guidance Counselor’s Letter	5 – Highest

We took these categories from the information requested on the application form.

The number of points allotted to each category reflects the importance of the information.

It will be fair to all entrants if all are judged by the same criteria.

The attached form is to be used by each club and the District in selecting a club or District winner.
